Sue Dove

Sue Dove is a mixed media artist, working across a number of processes, predominantly painting, collage and embroidery. Although also involved with rag-rug making, mosaic and felt-making, mixed media sketchbooks and stitch are her main loves.

Sue uses sketchbooks on a daily basis, producing many highly engaging, colourful, eclectic books, from which she develops finished pieces. *"I always work in sketchbooks ...collage with oil pastels and mono-printing straight into my book - drawing, painting, working out ideas before I commit to stitch."* Sue finds it a relaxing, no pressure way of working through ideas and options resulting in many rich, colourful books that are artworks in their own right. She also refers back to older work to revisit the images, often developing them into finished pieces using prints and stitch.





Sue has a degree in Textile Design from Liverpool Polytechnic. She lives in Cornwall where she works and teaches and is a member of the **Makers Emporium in St Just West Penwith Cornwall**. Teaching in 2019 has included two winter schools for **Fibre Forum with Glenys Mann in Australia**, and the **Granary Studio**, **Hants UK**.

Together with Jill Denton, Sue had a major exhibition 'Our Artful Lives' at the Knitting and Stitching shows in 2015. She exhibits in and around Cornwall and is also a member of St Ives Society of Artists.
